## Lesson 2: Zoonotic Disease Transmission - Routes of Transmission Worksheet

<u>Instructions</u>: Match the route of transmission to ways it can be prevented. Only one letter may be used per blank, but letters may be used more than once.

## **Routes of Transmission:**

- A. Direct Contact
- B. Aerosol/Droplet
- C. Indirect Contact
- D. Ingestion (Oral)
- E. Vectors

## **Ways to Prevent Disease Transmission:**

1.	Use insect control products
2.	Isolate sick animals
3.	Provide fresh air to humans and animals
4.	Dispose of or wash boots and clothing after animal contact
5.	Wash your hands before preparing food
6.	Work with your veterinarian to check and treat your animals for parasites
7.	Wear gloves when working with sick animals
8.	Store food at the proper temperature
9.	Wear respiratory protection when working with animals
10.	Decrease humidity and odor build-up in barns
11.	Clean and disinfect any equipment used with sick animals
12.	Increase the distance between healthy and sick animals
13.	Wash your hands after cleaning pens or contact with manure
14.	Cook meat to the appropriate internal temperature
15.	Avoid sharing equipment, or clean and disinfect equipment when sharing is necessary
