- 1. Swine flu (Influenza A) is caused by a virus in farm animals that like to roll around in the mud.
- 2. This purring, whiskered house pet can sometimes spread an infection called ringworm, which causes circular rashes on the skin. Good hygiene can prevent it from spreading.
- 3. Anaplasmosis is a disease that comes from this small insect that burrows into the skin of people and animals and makes them sick.
- **4.** This animal sleeps with its eyes open to protect itself from predators.
- 6. A farm animal that has a wooly coat and rectangular pupils.
- 7. Animal with antlers and is often seen in the forest.
- 9. E. Coli is a type of bacteria that can be passed from this large livestock animal to people.
- 10. This animal lives in the water and uses its fins to swim. It can also carry a bacteria that causes botulism in rare cases.
